Hastings Public Schools' SUPERINTENDENT SEARCH

Our vision for the future starts here.

The School Board of Hastings Public Schools is conducting a search for a new superintendent who will begin leading the district in July. The school board contracted with the Minnesota School Boards Association (MSBA) to provide guidance and to assist with the search.

The session will be facilitated by members of the Minnesota School Board's Association (MSBA). Attendees will be asked to work in small groups to answer predetermined questions which will help MSBA work with the School Board to determine what the district is looking for in candidates. In addition, the questions will aid the school board in the formulation of questions to be used once candidates to be interviewed have been selected.

As the board continues to go through the selection process there are also a number of Special School Board Meetings related to the interviewing and hiring of the new superintendent, and these meetings are open to the public. All meetings will take place in the Board Room at the ISD #200 District Office, 1000 West 11th Street. The dates, times and topics for each of these meetings leading up to the final selection of a new superintendent are listed below:

Monday, March 2nd, 2020, 4:00 PM - Develop Interview Questions for Superintendent Interviews

Tuesday, March 24th, 2020, 6:30 PM - Determine Superintendent Interviewees for Round One Interviews.

Monday, March 30th, 2020, 8:00 AM - Round One Interviews for Superintendent Position.

Tuesday, March 31st, 2020 at 8:00 AM - Round One Interviews continue.

Thursday, April 2nd, 2020 at 2:00 PM, - Round Two Interviews for Superintendent Position.
